Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza – Revocation of declaration of infected place

1. This is a revocation of a declaration of infected place by James Peter Wilson, Director of Natural Resources under article 6(2) of the Animal Health (Emergency Measures for Outbreaks of Infectious Diseases) Order 2022 (“the Order”).
2. The declaration as an infected place of the area of Stanley Common known as the **entire Gentoo penguin colony at Yorke Bay** (“the premises”) made under article 5(4) of the Order, and published in Extraordinary Gazette Number 33 on 1 December 2025 as notice number 132, is revoked.
3. The revocation is made after having consulted the Senior Veterinary Officer in accordance with article 6(3) of the Order, and I am satisfied that:-
 - (a) infection or contamination of avian influenza is no longer present at the premises; and
 - (b) compliance with biosecurity guidance as required by the declaration is no longer a legal requirement but remains highly recommended.
4. This revocation is with effect from 30 March 2026.

3. The revocation is made after having consulted the Senior Veterinary Officer in accordance with article 6(3) of the Order, and I am satisfied that:-
 - (a) infection or contamination of avian influenza is no longer present at the premises; and
 - (b) compliance with biosecurity guidance as required by the declaration is no longer a legal requirement but remains highly recommended.
4. This revocation is with effect from 30 March 2026.
