Retail Prices Index

The Retail Prices Index for the quarter ended 30 June 2024 has now been completed.

The Index has increased by 0.5% to 124.810. The change in the Index over the year to 30 June 2024 has been +2.5%.

Quarter 2 data points show a broad weakening in price pressures and is an encouraging sign that Stanley inflation has resumed its downward path after prices rose more quickly than expected through the first quarter. The Index rose by 2.5% between quarter 2 2023 and quarter 2 2024, down from an annual increase of 3.1% in the 12 months to quarter 1 2024. Meanwhile, on a quarterly basis retail

prices grew by 0.5% between quarter 1 and quarter 2, compared with a rise of 0.6% in the first quarter of the year. The easing in annual inflation rates in quarter 2 reflected downward contributions from two classes, namely ‘energy’ and ‘health’ prices, partially offset by upward contributions from the components of ‘food and non-alcoholic beverages’ and ‘restaurants and hotels’. The largest downward contribution to the quarterly change in the Index came from ‘transport’ and ‘health’, while ‘food and non-alcoholic beverages’ provided the largest, partially offsetting, upward contribution.

The components in the basket with the largest increases in the 12 months to quarter 2 2024 were ‘food and non-alcoholic beverages’ (1.3%) and ‘restaurants and hotels’ (+0.5%). Once again, the largest downward impact came from ‘fuel and power’ (-0.3%), in addition to health (-0.3%).

Among all classes, prices of ‘food and non-alcoholic beverages’ rose by 0.7% quarter on quarter during quarter 2, up from 0.4% in quarter 1. It is worth highlighting that the quarter 2 figure is the highest quarterly rate since quarter 2 2023 and the rate picked up for the second consecutive quarter after it briefly edged into negative territory in the final quarter of last year.

Meanwhile, ‘energy’ inflationary pressures, particularly kerosene, remained broadly contained in quarter 2. Specifically, both quarterly and annual kerosene sub-indexes came in at -0.1% and +0.2% respectively, compared with +0.4% and +0.2% during quarter 1. Electricity price growth continued to contribute negatively (-0.5%) to annual inflation while the quarter-on-quarter growth remained flat during the quarter.

Falkland Islands Constitution Order 2008
section 84

Police Ordinance 2000
section 4

Appointment of Chief Police Officer

1. Section 84(4) and (5) of the Constitution provides that the power to make appointment to the office of Chief of Police is vested in, and shall be exercised by the Governor, in his or her discretion.

2. Section 4(1) of the Police Ordinance 2000 provides that the Governor, acting in his discretion, shall appoint a person to be the chief police officer.

3. In exercise of my powers under section 84(4) and (5) of the Constitution and section 4(1) of the Police Ordinance 2000, I appoint **Albert Armah Dann** to be the Chief Police Officer.

4. In accordance with my powers under section 4(3) of the Police Ordinance 2000 I direct that during the period of appointment as the Chief Police Officer, Albert Armah Dann will hold the rank of Superintendent.

5. This appointment has effect from 18 June 2024 and continues in effect for the duration of Albert Armah Dann’s contract of employment with the Falkland Islands Government in the post of Chief Police Officer, unless terminated sooner.
