Retail Prices Index

The Retail Prices Index (“Index”) for the quarter ended 31 December 2025 has now been completed.

The Index has increased by 0.2% to 126.626. The change in the Index over the year to 31 December 2025 has been 2.1%.

Quarterly change: Inflation increased marginally this quarter driven largely by the increase in landline prices in October and the cost of food and non-alcoholic drinks. The latter reflects high inflation experienced by the food and drink sector in the United Kingdom in 2025. New unlimited packages have now been incorporated into the price of internet in the basket of goods, which had a slight deflationary impact. Further drops arising from the communications category are expected as the lower two broadband packages (which have the highest cost per MB) are phased out.

Annual change: Annual inflation is still being kept in check by drops in fuel prices in 2024 and early 2025. The impact of housing costs and services over the 12-month period is noticeable, as is the

increase to food and non-alcoholic drinks which, again, reflects the high inflation experienced by the sector in the United Kingdom in 2025.

Outlook: Inflation in the United Kingdom food and drink sector in 2026 is forecast to remain high for much of the year, and that is likely to continue to have an impact on the cost of food and non-alcoholic drink in the Falkland Islands. As noted above, the deflationary impact of fuel price drops over the last two years will likely end in quarter 3 2026 if current price trends continue. It is unlikely that the current shipping disruption will impact the Index, as prices will be collected in the fourth week of March, by which time most goods are expected to be back in stock.

**Administration of Justice (Payments to Jurors and Witnesses)
Rules 2016
rule 5**

Rates of costs and expenses for witnesses and jurors

The Attorney General sets the following rates in accordance with rule 5 of the Administration of Justice (Payments to Jurors and Witnesses) Rules 2016:-

(1) Travelling expenses (rule 10)

Public transport including air travel (standard/economy class travel only at cost).

Motorcycle or car 40 pence per mile (where more than one person travels together only the driver may claim).

Taxis (may only be claimed with the prior permission of the court). If permission is given the actual fare without gratuity will be paid. A receipt must be produced.

(2) Daily subsistence allowance (rule 9)

(a) Daily rate - up to 5 hours - £7

(b) Daily rate - over 5 hours - £21

(3) Additional expenditure or loss of earnings allowance (rule 8)

For loss of earnings, you must show that you have suffered a financial loss e.g. your employer did not pay you because you are a casual worker or if self-employed someone was actually employed to substitute whilst you were away. These are not the only examples and any loss you have actually suffered will be considered by the Court but you should provide evidence to support your claim. The court will require you to provide a certificate of loss of earnings which must be signed by your employer.

For additional expenditure - you may claim if you are the primary carer for a child or dependent adult and you have to pay for alternative care because of your attendance at court. The court will require evidence of cost of alternative care.

Your actual costs will be reimbursed up to the daily maximums set out below:-

During the first ten days attendance:-

(a) of up to four hours - £80

(b) over four hours - £160

Day eleven onwards:-

(a) of up to four hours - £120

(b) over four hours - £240

(4) Overnight subsistence allowance (rules 7 and 9)

If overnight accommodation is required by the court this will be arranged and paid for by the court.

Normally overnight accommodation is not allowed. However, if you live beyond a reasonable commuting distance of where the court hearing will take place overnight accommodation may be paid for. To make a claim you must get permission from the court in advance. Basic bed and breakfast rate will be paid.

If staying with friends or family a claim of £31 overnight subsistence allowance per 24 hour period can be claimed.

**Animal Health (Emergency Measures for Outbreaks of
Infectious Diseases) Order 2022
article 6**

**Highly Pathogenic Avian influenza – Revocation of
declaration of infected place**

1. This is a revocation of a declaration of infected place by James Peter Wilson, Director of Natural Resources under article 6(2) of the Animal Health (Emergency Measures for Outbreaks of Infectious Diseases) Order 2022 ("the Order").

2. The declaration as an infected place of an area known as the **Gentoo Colony at White Rock, Port Howard** ("the premises") made under article 5(4) of the Order, and published in

Extraordinary Gazette Number 1 on 16 January 2026 as notice number 1, is revoked.

3. The revocation is made after having consulted the Senior Veterinary Officer in accordance with article 6(3) of the Order, and I am satisfied that:-

(a) infection or contamination of Avian Influenza is no longer present at the premises; and

(b) compliance with biosecurity guidance as required by the declaration is no longer a legal requirement but remains highly recommended.

4. This revocation is with effect from 27 February 2026.
