Listed buildings and structures

The following buildings and structures have been designated as being of special architectural or historic interest under section 65 of the Planning Ordinance 1991. They are commonly referred to as 'listed' buildings.

The designation (listing) of a building means that planning permission is required for any alterations and extensions to the building which would affect its character as a building with special architectural or historic interest. The usual allowances to undertake certain works without making a planning application do not apply (there are no 'permitted development' rights).

Depending on the details of the designation this means that planning permission may be needed for any internal works to the building and/or for any works within the boundary of the property, as well as for any external changes to the building. Planning permission is also likely to be required for any demolition works, including of outbuildings such as sheds.

If you are thinking of undertaking any works please contact Planning and Building Services for advice, both to check if a planning application will be needed and to discuss whether or not the proposals are likely to be acceptable.
