Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza

Declaration of infected place

1. This is a declaration under article 5(4) (declaration of infected place) of the Animal Health (Emergency Measures for Outbreaks of Infectious Diseases) Order 2022 (“**the Order**”) by James Peter Wilson, Director of Natural Resources (“the Director”).
2. The Director has declared the area of Beauchene Island as depicted on the map in Schedule 2, to be an infected place (“**the premises**”)
3. This declaration is made on the grounds that the Senior Veterinary Officer of the Falkland Islands Government has concluded that highly pathogenic avian influenza exists or has in the previous 56 days been present on the infected place.
4. While this declaration is in force, the restrictions or requirements in paragraph 5 and Schedule 1, being measures to be taken to contain and limit the spread of disease, apply.
5. (1) The following must comply with biosecurity guidance during the period of operation of this declaration —
 - (a) any person entering or leaving the premises;
 - (b) any person who has charge of animals or poultry; and
 - (c) any person who is under the direction of a person mentioned in subparagraphs (a) and (b).

6. This declaration is in force until revoked by the Director in accordance with article 6(2) of the Order.

SCHEDULE 1

Restrictions and requirements

(a) Restrictions relating to animals and people:

(i) no domestic animals or poultry may be moved on or off the premises except in terms of a licence issued under article 9 of the Order; and

(ii) movement of persons on or over the premises is restricted in accordance with Article 7B of the Order.

(b) Research involving handling wild birds is not permitted during the time the declaration is in place unless it is specifically for HPAI research.

Note: Article 7B of the Order provides that the following persons are not subject to movement restrictions imposed on persons under an infected place declaration:

(a) the owner or occupier of the premises;

(b) any person whose principal residence or place of employment is those premises;

(c) any person entering under the authority of a licence granted under article 9 of the Order.
